Award Categories:

1. Best Band or Musical Group
2. Best Family group or float
3. Best Camp group or float
4. Best Local organization, club or business
5. Best Individual or neighborhood group
6. Best Antique Vehicle (Pre 1950)
7. Best Classic Vehicle (Post 1950)
8. Best Unique entry
9. Best Cardboard Boat design (visually)

Judging Criteria for Floats and Groups:

1. Parade Theme (maximum of 20 points awarded)
(How well the float, organization or group adapts to the parade theme)
2. Originality (maximum of 20 points awarded)
(The creativeness and originality in the float, organization or groups design concept)
3. Workmanship (maximum of 20 points awarded)
(The craftsmanship of the float or detail, ingenuity and creation of non-float participants with the effective use of colors or materials)
4. Public Appeal (maximum of 20 points awarded)
(Public appeal is the enjoyment of the float, group or organization by the parade audience. Quality of the first 3 criteria will affect their enjoyment)
5. Overall effort and final result (maximum of 20 points awarded)
(The overall effective presentation and enthusiasm of the float, group or organization)

Awards:

2010 Judges Grand Prize Trophy (Trophy awarded for the best over-all parade entry. (This entry must receive points in all 5 judging criteria)

Spirit Award (Trophy awarded to the entry that best personifies a spirit of enthusiasm, ingenuity and originality and brings the greatest pleasure to and response from the spectators.)
